between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 1 p.m., and 2.30 p.m. and 5 p.m. on every week-day except Saturday, and on Saturday between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12 noon; (3) Any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area, and any association representing owners of property within the Urban District of Eastleigh, and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Southern Hampshire Joint Planning Committee to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme;

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Eastleigh Urban District Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited, together with the aforesaid map.

The Southern Hampshire Joint Planning Committee intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Secretary to the Committee.
