East Suffolk Rivers (excluding the River Waverney) Catchment Board.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries hereby gives notice that the East Suffolk Rivers (excluding the River Waverney) Catchment Board have made application under subsection (3) of Section 5 of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, that the approved map of the Catchment Area be varied so far as relates to the extent of the "main river," by adding to the "main river" as shown on the said map the following watercourses or parts thereof in addition to the watercourses referred to in

the Notice published by the Minister on the 18th February, 1935.

1. The tributary of the River Gipping from the Old Gun Cotton Lock at Stowmarket to Rattlesden.

2. The Cut in the River Gipping between Bosmere Mill and Barking Mill.

3. Shottisham River from the sluice at Shottisham Creek to the Fish Pond above Shottisham Mill.

4. Bucklesham Mill River from Brightwell Road Bridge to the Western boundary of the River Deben (Lower) Internal Drainage District.
