

Parishes of the character contemplated by the Act of the 6th and 7th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 37, by the Act of the 19th and 20th years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 104, and by the above mentioned Act of the 32nd and 33rd years of Her said late Majesty, Chapter 94:

"And whereas it has been represented to us, and it appears to us to be expedient that the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton, the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, and the said New Parish of Saint Augustine, Gillingham, should be altered in the manner which is hereinafter mentioned:

"Now, therefore, with the consent of the Right Reverend Martin, Bishop of Rochester (in testimony whereof he has signed and sealed this Scheme or Representation), we, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners, humbly represent, recommend and propose that from and after the day of the date of the publication in the London Gazette of an Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme or Representation and without any assurance in the law other than such duly gazetted Order the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton, the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, and the said New Parish of Saint Augustine, Gillingham, shall be altered so that (first) all those portions of the said Parish of Gillingham, and of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, which are described in the First Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured green shall be dissevered from such Parish and New Parish respectively and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton; (secondly) all that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, which is described in the Second Schedule hereunder written and is delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and is thereon coloured blue shall be dissevered from such New Parish and shall be restored to and shall in future form part of the said Parish of Gillingham; and (thirdly) all those portions of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, and of the said Parish of Gillingham, which are described in the Third Schedule hereunder written and are delineated and set forth upon the said map or plan hereunto annexed and are thereon coloured pink shall be dissevered from such New Parish and Parish respectively and shall be annexed to and shall in future form part of the said New Parish of Saint Augustine, Gillingham.

"And we further represent, recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from representing, recommending and proposing any other measures relating to the matters aforesaid or any of them in accordance with the provisions of the hereinbefore mentioned Acts or any of them or any other Act of Parliament.

"THE SCHEDULES to which the foregoing Scheme or Representation has reference.

*"The First Schedule.*

"The territory to be annexed to the New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton, in the

County of Kent and in the Diocese of Rochester, comprising:—

"All that isolated portion of the Parish of Gillingham, and also all that contiguous portion of the New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, both in the said County and Diocese, which taken together, are bounded upon the north-west partly by the main portion of the said Parish of Gillingham and partly by the said New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton, upon the west and upon the south-west by the last mentioned New Parish, and upon the remaining sides, that is to say, upon the south-east, upon the east, and upon the north, by an imaginary line commencing at the point where the boundaries of the said New Parish of Saint Mark, New Brompton, of the said isolated portion of the Parish of Gillingham, and of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, all meet at the junction of Copenhagen Road and Gillingham Road and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Gillingham Road (thereby following the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, from the said isolated portion of the Parish of Gillingham) for a distance of 8 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Duncan Road, and extending thence north-eastward along the middle of Duncan Road for a distance of 16 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Balmoral Road, and extending thence first north-westward and then south-westward along the middle of Balmoral Road for a distance of 7 chains or thereabouts to its junction with the bridge leading across the main line of the Eastern Section of the Southern Railway into High Street, and extending thence north-westward for a distance of 1 chain or thereabouts to the centre of such bridge upon the boundary which divides the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, from the main portion of the said Parish of Gillingham.

*"The Second Schedule.*

"The territory to be dissevered from the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, and to be restored to the said Parish of Gillingham, being:—

"All that portion of the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, which is bounded upon the east, upon the north-east, and upon the north-west by the said Parish of Gillingham, and upon the remaining side, that is to say, upon the south, by an imaginary line commencing upon the boundary which divides the said Parish of Gillingham from the said New Parish of Saint Barnabas, Gillingham, at the centre of the bridge which connects High Street with Balmoral Road, across the main line of the Eastern Section of the Southern Railway, and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of the said bridge for a distance of 1 chain or thereabouts to its junction with Balmoral Road, and extending thence first north-eastward and then south-eastward along the middle of Balmoral Road for a distance of 25 chains or thereabouts to its junction with Gillingham Road, and extending thence south-westward along the middle of Gillingham Road for a distance of 6½ chains or thereabouts to its junction with Livingstone Road, and extending thence south-eastward along the middle of Living-
