

said enclosure on the south-east by land belonging to or reputed to belong to Harry Horridge and on the north-east by an imaginary line drawn 38 feet to the southward of and parallel to the rear curtilages of the houses numbered 31 to 49 Old Wargrave Road.

The Order will vary or extinguish all rights and privileges which would impede or interfere with its purposes and confer other rights and privileges.

II. To incorporate with the Order all or some of the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Act 1847 and the Gasworks Clauses Act 1871.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 7th October, 1935.

Any such objection shall state:—

- (a) The specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) The omissions, additions or modifications asked for.
