enacted that His Majesty, if satisfied that the Government of any country has ratified the Load Line Convention, may, by Order in Council, make a declaration to that effect:

And whereas His Majesty is satisfied that the Government of Belgium has ratified the Load Line Convention:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, in pursuance of the powers vested in Him by the aforesaid Section, and of all other powers enabling Him in that behalf, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to declare and doth hereby declare that the Government of Belgium has ratified the Load Line Convention.

WHEREAS by an Order in Council, bearing date the 6th day of June, 1935, it was ordered that the Michaelmas Sittings of the Court of Appeal and of the High Court of Justice should in the year 1935 commence on the 7th day of October, and the Long Vacation of the several Courts and Offices of the Supreme Court should for all purposes terminate on the 6th day of October in the same year:

And whereas it is expedient that consequential alterations should be made in the dates for the holding of certain Assizes:

And whereas the provisions of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, have been complied with:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:---

1. The Schedules to the Order in Council dated the 14th day of May, 1912, so far as they relate to the Commission days on the Midland, Oxford, Western and Northern Circuits, shall, with regard to the Autumn Assizes for the year 1935 only, be suspended, and the Schedule to this Order shall pro tanto be substituted therefor.

2. This Order shall not affect the existing powers of altering Commission days.

3. This Order may be cited as the Autumn Circuit (1935) Order, 1935.
