

(iii) Any Coalowner desiring an allotment of Pool Tonnage shall make application in writing to the Secretary, stating the amount of Pool Tonnage which he desires to have allotted to him and the detailed grounds on which the application is made.

(iv) The Export Committee shall from time to time consider all applications for allotment, and shall allot to each applicant such Pool Tonnage as they shall deem necessary having regard to the grounds specified by each Coalowner in his application and to all other material circumstances not excluding prices.

(v) The price per ton at which Pool Tonnage is allotted during any month shall be sixpence.

(vi) Payments for Pool Tonnage shall be made by each Coalowner receiving an allotment not later than the last day of the month in which such tonnage is allotted. The amount of such payments shall be distributed by the Secretary each month among the Coalowners who passed such tonnage into the Pool according to the quantity of Pool Tonnage allotted on behalf of each such Coalowner.

(vii) All allotments of Pool Tonnage shall be deemed to be made on account of all Coalowners who shall have Pool Tonnage standing to their credit and all such allotments shall be allocated rateably and in proportion to the amount of the Pool Tonnage of each Coalowner at the time when the allotments were made.

(viii) Tonnage in the Pool at 30th April in any year shall not be deemed to be cancelled unless the Quota Committee shall otherwise decide.

(ix) The Quota Committee shall have power to resolve at any time that no further Export Supply Shortage shall be deemed to be registered in the Pool during such period as they shall decide.

(x) Every Coalowner receiving an allotment of Pool Tonnage shall be entitled to raise such excess output (but no more) as shall enable him to supply the amount of such allotment and the Executive Board shall reduce or cancel (as the case may be) any penalty incurred by a Coalowner in respect of any excess output to the extent that the excess shall have been necessary for the purposes of this sub-clause. In the event of any penalty being cancelled or reduced by the Executive Board under the provisions of this sub-clause the tonnage of output in respect of which the penalty was so reduced or cancelled shall not be carried forward and debited under the provisions of sub-clause (4) of Clause 18 of the Scheme.

(xi) All Pool Tonnage allotted shall be deemed to be part of the monthly permitted export supply of the Coalowners to whom an allotment has been made and no portion of such allotted Pool Tonnage shall be sold or supplied as part of any Coalowner's monthly permitted Inland supply.

(xii) The Executive Board shall appoint an independent arbitrator to whom any dispute arising out of the provisions of

this sub-clause shall be referred for decision. The arbitrator immediately upon appointment shall give directions as to the procedure to be followed and as to the method of conducting arbitrations and the provisions of paragraphs (a), (b), (c) and (d) of Clause 28 of the Scheme shall not apply to such arbitrations."

B. Clause 17 of the Scheme shall have effect as if at the end of sub-clause (d) thereof there were added the following paragraph:—

"(vi) to carry out the duties prescribed for them by sub-clause (m) of Clause 16 hereof."
