WELLINGBOROUGH GAS (No. 2).

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade forthwith by the Wellingborough Gas Light Company Limited (hereinafter called "the Company") whose address is Commercial Place, Wellingborough, for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following (amongst other) purposes (that is to say):—

1. To extend the limits within which the Company are authorised to supply gas so as to include the following area (hereinafter referred to as "the added limits"):

In the County of Northampton:—

So much of the former urban district of Irthlingborough as was transferred to the urban district of Wellingborough by the County of Northampton (Wellingborough Extension) Review Order 1935.

2. To provide that subject to the provisions of the intended Order the Company shall have and may exercise within the added limits or any part or parts thereof all powers, rights and privileges which they have within the remainder of their limits of supply for the time being or some part or parts thereof.

3. To authorise the Company to continue, maintain and use any gas mains, pipes and works in the added limits which may have been or may hereafter be transferred to or vested in them and to apply to such mains, pipes and works the provisions of the intended Order and of the Acts incorporated therewith and of the Wellingborough Gas Orders 1879 to 1922.

4. To make provisions as to the declaration of the calorific value or values of and to define the price which may be charged by the Company for gas supplied within the added limits.

5. To repeal, alter or amend all or some of the provisions of the Wellingborough Gas Orders 1879 to 1922 and any other Act or Order relating to the Company or their undertaking.

6. To incorporate with the Order with or without modification or to render inapplicable all or some of the provisions of the Gasworks Clauses Act 1847, and the Gasworks Clauses Act 1871.

Any local or other public authority, company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration, Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 2nd day of December, 1935.

Any such objection shall state:—

- (a) the specific grounds of objection; and
- (b) the omissions, additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must at the same time be forwarded to the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents.

A copy of the draft Special Order and an Ordnance Map showing the situation of the existing works of the Company and the boundaries of the existing area of supply and of the added limits have been deposited for public inspection with the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Northampton at his office at County Hall, Northampton, and at the offices of the Company at Commercial Place, Wellingborough.

Printed copies of the draft Special Order may be obtained at the offices of the Company as aforesaid, and of the undermentioned Parliamentary Agents at the price of one shilling per copy.
