#### PHARMACY AND POISONS ACT, 1933.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that the Secretary of State for the Home Department proposes after the expiration of forty days from this date, to make Rules under Section 21 of the Pharmacy and Poisons Act, 1933, prescribing the manner of an appeal by a person aggrieved by the refusal of a local authority to enter his name in the list kept by that authority in pursuance of Section 21 of the Act or by the removal of his name from the said list by the local authority.

The Rules, which are intended to come into force on May 1st, 1936, require that such an appeal shall be made in accordance with the provisions of the Quarter Sessions Act, 1849, to the next practicable Court of Quarter Sessions having jurisdiction in the county or borough in which the premises of the appellant are situate and held not less than twenty-one clear days after notification of the refusal or removal, as the case may be, is given to him by the local authority.
