## IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes (No. ) (Selsdon) Regulations, 1936, in regard to a scheme of "one-way" traffic working on the southern side of the triangular island site at the junction of Old Farleigh Road and Addington Road, Selsdon, Surrey.

For the purposes of the Electricity (Supply) Acts, 1882 to 1935, and all Orders and Licenses made or granted and issued thereunder, and

any Local Act relating to the supply of electricity, the Electricity Commissioners approve of the construction and pattern of the meter (hereinafter described) for the measurement of electrical energy when supplied on the constant pressure two wire, single phase, alternating current system at a frequency of 50 cycles per second and known as the British Sangamo Type H.E. Single Phase Watthour Meter, of rated sizes 2½, 5, 10, 20 and 50 amperes and 110, 200, 220, 230, 440 and 550 volts.

Provided that the meter be constructed as described in the specification and drawings deposited at the National Physical Laboratory, Teddington, Middlesex, dated 17th July, 1926, and numbered 116, 8th April, 1930, 25th June, 1931, 6th April, 1933, and 26th November, 1935, and numbered 129, and be in accordance with one of the pattern meters Nos. 3490983, 3498123, A.3512312, A.3821022, 5143109, 5147195, 5508362 and 5931477, deposited at the National Physical Laboratory on the 7th July, 1926, 22nd September, 1926, 31st January, 1927, 11th March, 1927, 16th April, 1930, 15th August, 1930, 21st May, 1931 and 6th April, 1933, by or on behalf of the British Sangamo Company, Limited, Cambridge Arterial Road, Enfield, Middlesex, and sealed by the National Physical Laboratory at the instance of the Electricity Commissioners.

The Electricity Commissioners further approve of the means provided for fixing meters of this description, and for connecting them with the service lines as described in the specification and drawings above referred to.

The approval by the Electricity Commissioners dated 4th May, 1933, of the construction and pattern of the British Sangamo Type H.E. (Single Phase Watthour Meter is hereby superseded.

## LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

*East Suffolk Rivers (excluding the River Waveney) Catchment Board.*

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made Orders under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the schemes submitted to him by the East Suffolk Rivers (excluding the River Waveney) Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (b) of that Act, making provision for the constitution of two new Internal Drainage Districts to be known as the Fromus, Alde and Thorpeness and the Upper Alde Internal Drainage Districts, and of Drainage Boards therefor; and for certain matters supplemental thereto, and that each of the Orders will become final and have effect as an Act of Parliament, unless within thirty-one days from the date of this Notice a Memorial is presented to the Minister by some person or body affected and having
