LIVERPOOL ELECTRICITY (EXTEN-SION) SPECIAL ORDER, 1936.

ELECTRICITY (SUPPLY) ACTS, 1882 TO 1935.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Electricity Commissioners have submitted to the Minister of Transport for confirmation under the above-mentioned Acts a Special Order made by them on the application of the Corporation of Liverpool to authorise, inter alia:—

(a) the extension of the Corporation's area of supply, so as to include the Urban Districts of Prescot and Huyton-with-Roby, part of the County Borough of St. Helens and part of the Rural District of Whiston in the County Palatine of Lancaster; and

(b) the purchase by the Corporation of the electricity undertaking of the British Insulated Cables Limited authorised by the Prescot Electric Lighting Order, 1895, and the Prescot (Extension) Electric Lighting Order, 1898, and by the Whiston Rural District Electric Lighting Order, 1898, so far as it relates to the area proposed to be added to the Corporation's area of supply.

The Minister of Transport proposes to confirm the Order and gives notice that any person affected who may be desirous of objecting to the confirmation of the same must, in
