

due west from the southernmost point of the enclosure numbered 474 on the $\frac{1}{2500}$ Ordnance Map (Edition of 1920) Monmouthshire Sheet XXIX.1 to the boundary of the parish of Llanhennock Fawr, and so much of the parish of Llanhennock Fawr in that rural district as is not within the existing limits;

(hereinafter called "the added limits") and to provide that subject to the provisions of the intended Order the Company shall have and may exercise within the added limits or any part or parts thereof all powers, rights and privileges which they have within their existing limits of supply or some part or parts thereof.

2. To empower the Company to purchase and take by agreement from the Coke Ovens of the British Benzole and Coal Distillation Company Limited in the parish of Bedwas in the urban district of Bedwas and Machen a supply of gas in bulk and for such purpose to lay mains and break up streets within and without the limits of supply.

3. To empower the Company to give separate supplies of gas for industrial purposes, to prescribe conditions as to the quality of gas given for such purposes and to impose restrictions on the giving and use of such gas.

4. To empower the Secretary of State for the Home Department to make or impose regulations, terms and conditions with respect to the supply of gas for industrial purposes.

5. To fix a basic price for the gas to be supplied by the Company and to make provision for the revision of such basic price and to enable the Company (if thought fit) to charge extra prices for gas supplied within the added limits.

6. To prescribe a basic rate of dividend on the consolidated ordinary stock of the Company, to empower the Company in certain circumstances to apply their profits in payment of dividends in excess of the basic rate or in appropriation to a reserve fund, and for the benefit of all or some of the employees of the Company, and to make provision for determining from time to time the amount (if any) of the profits to be applied as aforesaid.

7. To make provision in regard to the formation by the Company of a reserve fund, a special purposes fund, a renewal fund and a redemption fund.

8. To make provision in regard to the reading of meter indices and as to the service of notices upon consumers.

9. To make provision as to the payment of half-yearly dividends by the directors without the sanction or direction of a general meeting.

10. To empower the Company to purchase by agreement any debentures or debenture stock of the Company and to apply their funds for the purpose and to provide that any debentures or debenture stock so purchased shall be cancelled.

11. To empower the Company to contract with any persons for the supply by the Company to them or to the Company by them of gas in bulk.

12. To empower the Company to acquire and deal with houses, offices, showrooms and other buildings for employees or for the purposes of the undertaking, and to provide and maintain recreation grounds for employees.

13. To empower the Company to sell and dispose of or let on lease any lands for the time being belonging to the Company and not required for the purposes of the undertaking.

14. To make provision as to the supply of gas to premises abutting on streets forming the boundary of, but outside, the limits of supply and as to the breaking-up of such streets for the purpose of affording such supply.

15. To authorise the Company on the lands hereinafter mentioned to erect and maintain gasholders with all necessary machinery and apparatus ancillary thereto, and to do all such acts as may be proper for storing and supplying gas. The lands above referred to are:

(1) ALL THAT piece of land situate at Bishpool in the parish of Newport in the county borough of Newport containing by admeasurement one acre or thereabouts forming a part of the enclosure numbered 468 on the $\frac{1}{2500}$ Ordnance Map (Edition of 1920) Monmouthshire Sheet XXIX.14 and being bounded on the east by the road running from Bishpool Common to Lis-werry on the south-west by the enclosure numbered 470 on the west by the enclosure numbered 466 and on the north by the remainder of the enclosure numbered 468 on the said Ordnance Map.

(2) ALL THAT piece of land situate at Mendalgyf in the parish of Newport in the county borough of Newport containing by admeasurement 1.715 acres or thereabouts and comprising the enclosure numbered 437 on the $\frac{1}{2500}$ Ordnance Map (Edition of 1921) Monmouthshire Sheet XXXIII. 4 and being bounded on the north-west by the road known as Maes-glas Road on the north-east by the enclosure numbered 434 on the south-east in part by the enclosure numbered 436 and in part by the enclosure numbered 453 and on the south-west by the enclosure numbered 452 on the said Ordnance Map.

16. To empower the Company to lay down and renew mains, pipes and culverts for purposes ancillary to the undertaking.

17. To empower the Company on the application of the owner or occupier of premises abutting on streets not dedicated to public use to supply those premises with gas.

18. To make provision for the prevention of improper use of gas, the position of gas meters, the inspection and testing of gas meters and the discontinuance of supplies of gas by the Company.

19. To empower the Company to make a charge for the special reading of gas meters.

20. To make provision as to the authentication and service of notices by the Company and as to the form and service of notices to the Company for the discontinuance of a supply of gas.

21. To make provision for the relief of the Company from obligation to give new or increased supplies of gas.

22. To empower the Company to put in force a co-partnership scheme to enable employees to participate in the profits of the undertaking and to make provision for the disposal of stock and deposits of co-partners on death.

23. To empower the Company to grant pensions and allowances, to establish a pension fund and to establish a superannuation scheme.
