THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT  
ACT, 1907.

NOTICE is hereby given that by an Order, dated the 29th day of April, 1936, the Minister of Health has declared that, on and after the 18th day of May, 1936, Section 30 (dangerous places to be repaired or enclosed) comprised in Part II of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall, subject to the provisions of Section 33 (which relates to the exemption of certain buildings) be in force in the several contributory places within the Rural District of Norton:

Provided that the said Section 30 shall have effect subject to the following condition:—

Nothing in this Section shall apply to any wall or other structure in so far as the same is used either for the support of any street or public footpath repairable by the inhabitants at large or for the protection of any such street or public footpath from damage or obstruction by reason of the surface of the street or footpath being above or below the level of the surface of the adjoining land unless the wall or other structure was built after the street or foot-

path became a highway repairable by the inhabitants at large by or at the expense of a person other than the highway authority responsible for the repair of the street or footpath.

A copy of the aforesaid Order may be inspected at the Rural District Council Offices, Town Hall, Malton, between the hours of 10 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any weekday excepting Thursdays.
