## RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiry of at least forty days from this date in pursuance of the power conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Act, 1930, to make Regulations in substitution for the Motor Vehicles (Construction and Use) Regulations, 1931, and all Regulations amending those Regulations.

## ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1934.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Transport under and by virtue of the provisions of paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of Section 1 of the Road Traffic Act, 1934, has made the Road Traffic Act, 1934 (Directions under paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of Section 1) (No. 2) Order, 1936, in respect of certain roads in the London Traffic Area.

The Order provides for the imposition of the speed limit of 30 miles per hour in five lengths of road and for its removal from two lengths of road.
