mines, quarries and minerals so excepted and. reserved to the said Dean and Chapter as aforesaid by the several indentures of Conveyance set out in the said Schedule hereto annexed and marked 'B' with all such powers for working, winning, getting and carrying away the said mines, quarries and minerals as. are respectively set out and contained in the said indentures of conveyance and also all the sum or sums of stock, particularly described in the Schedule marked 'C' and all the interest of the said Dean and Chapter therein, shall be transferred to us in the manner contemplated by the same Act and that we shall be entitled to the rents, profits and proceeds thereof or interest or dividends due in respect thereof as the case may be as from the 25th day of March 1935 and that in consideration of and for such transfer to us as aforesaid there shall be paid by us to the said Dean and Chapter by equal quarterly payments on the 25th day of March, the 24th day of June, the 29th day of September, and 25th day of December in every year, the fixed annual sum of £7,210; and that the first quarterly payment of the said fixed annual sum shall be deemed to have become due and payable on the 24th day of June, 1935; and that the receipt or receipts of the Treasurer for the time being of the said Dean and Chapter shall be a good and valid discharge to us for all or any and every such sum or sums of money as shall therein be expressed to have been paid to him by us under the authority of such Order as aforesaid:

"And we further recommend and propose that the provisions of the hereinbefore recited Order of Her said late (Majesty in Council, bearing date the 8th day of August, 1853, relating to the incomes of the Dean and Canons of

the said Cathedral Church shall as from the said 25th day of March 1935 cease and be of no

"And we further recommend and propose that out of the said annual sum of £7,210 to be paid by us in accordance with the recommendations hereinbefore contained to the said Dean and Chapter the annual sum of £3,000, part thereof, shall be appropriated by the said Dean and Chapter to the payment of the income of the Dean and Canons, that is to say, not less than £1,000 for the income of the Dean and not less than £500 for the income of each of the Canons:

the Canons:
"And we further recommend and propose that there shall also be appropriated out of the said annual sum of £7,210 a sum of £800 for the repair and maintenance of the fabric of the Cathedral, the boundary wall of the Precincts and the Almshouses and also a further sum of £400 for the maintenance of the Grammar School and that the annual sum of £3,010 remaining out of the said sum of £7,210 together with the net income which may accrue to the said Dean and Chapter from any other source, shall be appropriated for the maintenance of the services of the said Cathedral Church and the payment of all the expenses and liabilities chargeable upon the revenues of the said Dean and Chapter and for such other purposes as they the said Dean and Chapter shall, in accordance with and subject to the regulations, orders and statutes which now or in the future shall govern their constitution, decide:

"And we further recommend and propose that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from recommending and proposing any further or other measures relating to the matters aforesaid, in conformity with the said Act or with any other Act of Parliament.
