

(iv) Every owner shall pay to the Board a sum calculated at such rate per ton not exceeding 1s. as the Board may from time to time decide for all tonnage distributed to him out of the pool. If a pool be opened in respect of the period of three months commencing on the 1st day of October, 1936, the rate shall be 1s. per ton. Any alteration of the rate of payment shall be decided by the Board not less than 28 days before the commencement of the pool period in which it is to come into force. The rate of payment for the time being so fixed by the Board is hereinafter referred to as "the full rate". Payment for any tonnage distributed to an owner under the provisions of this Clause shall become due immediately on notification to him of the amount of tonnage so distributed.

(v) The moneys received by the Board under paragraph (iv) of this Clause in respect of tonnage distributed out of the pool during a pool period shall be applied as soon as possible after the end of that period in the following manner:—

First such moneys shall be divided among all owners who during the first part of the pool period have transferred tonnage to the pool and such division shall be in proportion to the tonnage so transferred but so that no owner shall thereby receive more than the full rate in respect of every ton so transferred.

Any moneys then remaining in the hands of the Board shall then be divided among all the owners who during the second part of the pool period have transferred tonnage to the pool and such division shall be in proportion to the tonnage so transferred but so that no owner shall thereby receive more than one-half of the full rate in respect of every ton so transferred."

3. Clause 10 shall be renumbered 10A and shall have effect as if for paragraph (i) thereof there were substituted the following paragraph, that is to say:—

"(i) Where quotas for output are determined for a period of less than 3 months arrangements may be made by any two owners whereby the output of coal or any class of coal from the coal mine of one owner may exceed the quota in respect thereof in any period where the other owner has agreed, whether for valuable consideration or not, to limit the corresponding output from his coal mine to a tonnage which is less than the quota in respect thereof by a tonnage not less than the tonnage by which such first-mentioned quota is exceeded. If the output from any coal mine exceeds any limit so agreed, for the purposes of Clause 21 of the Scheme the corresponding quota shall be deemed to be exceeded by the amount of the excess over such limit."

4. Clause 21 shall have effect as if in paragraph (i) (a) (1) thereof for the words in parenthesis after the word "quota" where that word appears for the second time there were substituted the words "(after allowing for any shortage carried forward under Clause 9 (xi) of the Scheme and any adjustment or arrangement under Clause 10 or Clause 10A of the Scheme)".
