NOTICE BY THE BOARD OF TRADE REGARDING AN APPLICATION BY THE DEAL CORPORATION FOR AN AMENDING ORDER UNDER SUBSECTION (3) OF SECTION 1 OF THE GAS REGULATION ACT 1920 IN RESPECT OF THE DEAL AND WALMER GAS COMPANY.

The Board of Trade hereby give notice that the Deal Corporation, having made application under Subsection (3) of Section 1 of the Gas Regulation Act 1920 for an Amending Order revising the powers of charging authorised by the Deal and Walmer Gas (Charges) Order 1921, in respect of the Deal and Walmer Gas Company, the Board propose to authorise a new standard price of 13.2d. per therm in lieu of the existing standard price of 15d. per therm.
