FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1936 (No. 19).

SUBJECT.

Declares the Area described in the Schedule to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925 and prescribes special provisions relating to imported animals.

SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

In the county of Southampton.

The county boroughs of Southampton and Bournemouth.

The boroughs of Lymington, Christchurch and Romsey.

The petty sessional divisions of New Forest, Ringwood, Lymington, Christchurch and Hythe.

The parishes of Fordingbridge, Woodgreen, Hale, Wellow, Romsey Extra, Nursling and Rownhams, Chilworth, West End, Hedge End, Botley, Bursledon, Hound, Hamble, Millbrook and Melchet Park and Plaitford.

In the county of Dorset.

The parish of West Parley.

In the county of Wilts.

The parishes of Redlynch and Landford.
