THE PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AMENDMENT ACT, 1907.

BY an Order dated the 28th day of October, 1936, the Minister of Health has declared that on and after the 16th day of November, 1936, the following provision of the Public Health Acts Amendment Act, 1907, shall be in force in the Urban District of Brixham, namely:—

Section 23, comprised in Part II of the Act, relating to "Streets and Buildings."

The above provision is declared to be in force subject as regards Section 23, to the conditions specified in the Order.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the Scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Richmond (Surrey) Borough Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the Scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

The Richmond (Surrey) Borough Council intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Clerk to the Council.
