STONY STRATFORD GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934.)

NOTICE is hereby given that application is intended to be made to the Board of Trade by the Stony Stratford Gas & Coke Company Limited (hereinafter referred to as "the Company") whose address and registered office is at: 79, High Street, Stony Stratford in the County of Buckingham for a Special Order (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") under and in pursuance of the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following, amongst other, purposes (that is to say):—

1. To authorise the Company to supply gas within so much of the Urban District of Wolverton as lies to the south-west of an imaginary straight line drawn in a south-easterly direction from the point where the boundary between the fields numbered 261 and 263 on the 2500 Ordnance Map, Buckinghamshire Sheet IX.11 and Northamptonshire Sheet LXIX.11 (Edition of 1925) meets the north-west bank of the River Ouse, to the point where the boundary between the Urban District of Wolverton and the parish of Bradwell Abbey crosses the north side of Watling Street, in the County of Buckingham and the Parishes of Cosgrove and Passenham in the Rural District of Towcester in the County of Northampton (in this notice referred to as "the limits of supply").

2. To enable the Company to continue maintain and use any mains pipes and other works belonging to them at the commencement of the Order within the limits of supply as if the same had been laid down or constructed under the powers of the Order.

3. To define and limit the capital and borrowing powers of the Company for the purposes of the undertaking to be authorised by the Order and to make provision as to the issue of capital by the Company.

4. To make provisions as to the sale of shares in the capital of the Company by auction or tender.

5. To empower the directors of the Company to reserve a proportion of any future issue of capital for exclusive offer to the employees and to the consumers of gas of the Company and to make provisions as to the conditions of issue.

6. To empower the Company with the consent of the Board of Trade to offer capital for subscription by employees and consumers of gas of the Company without first offering the same for sale by public auction or tender.

7. To make provision as to the profits of the Company in respect of the said undertaking which may be divided among the shareholders.

8. To empower the Company to maintain erect alter improve and renew gasworks with all necessary machinery and apparatus and to make and store gas and to work up and convert residual products upon a piece of land in the Urban District of Wolverton containing by admeasurement 3 roods and 10 perches or thereabouts bounded on the south-west by High Street, on the north-west by Field No. 4 on the 2500 Ordnance Map Buckinghamshire Sheet IX.10 Northamptonshire Sheet LXI.10 (Edition of 1925), on the north-east by Field No. 5A on the said Ordnance Map, on the south-east partly by the said Field No. 5A and partly by a right of way belonging or reputed to belong to Arthur Andrew Tombs and to purchase and use material required to work up and convert residual products.

9. To empower the Company to purchase by agreement and to hold and use additional lands for the purposes of their undertaking and to acquire provide maintain and equip grounds for games sports or recreation for the use of their employees, and to provide dwellinghouses for their employees and offices and showrooms.

10. To make provision as to the declaration by the Company from time to time of the calorific value of the gas to be supplied by them and the alteration of such calorific value and to make provision as to the pressure of the gas to be supplied by the Company.

11. To fix a maximum price for gas to be supplied by the Company within the limits of supply.

12. To provide that the Company shall charge for gas supplied by them according to the number of heat units contained therein and to make provisions as to the method of ascertainment of the number of heat units supplied.

13. To provide that certain of the provisions of the Gas Regulation Act, 1920 (as amended by any subsequent Act) shall apply to the Company as if certain of the provisions of the Order (including those as to price) were an Order made under section 1 of the said Act of 1920.

14. To make special provisions as to the supply of gas to premises abutting on streets forming the boundary of the limits of supply and as to the breaking up of streets for the purpose of affording such supply.

15. To make provision with respect to:—
The charges for gas supplied by means of prepayment meters; the specification and regulation of the materials, size and position and the laying of pipes, fittings and appliances on the premises of consumers; the laying of pipes in private streets; the laying of pipes for ancillary purposes; the supply of
