

work at a time when such reproduction or performance would, but for the making of this Order, have been lawful, nothing in this Order shall diminish or prejudice any rights or interest arising from or in connection with such action which are subsisting and valuable at the said date unless the person who, by virtue of this Order, becomes entitled to restrain such reproduction or performance agrees to pay such compensation as failing agreement may be determined by arbitration.

5. The Interpretation Act 1889 (52-3 V. c. 63), shall apply to the interpretation of this Order as it applies to the interpretation of an Act of Parliament.

6. This Order may be cited as the Copyright (North Borneo) Order, 1937.

The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Saint John Baptist College, in the University of Oxford, on the 2nd day of *February*, 1937, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

EX-PARTE THE PRESIDENT AND FELLOWS OF SAINT JOHN BAPTIST COLLEGE IN THE UNIVERSITY OF OXFORD.

A STATUTE made to amend certain Statutes framed by the Commissioners appointed under the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923 (13 and 14 Geo. 5 Ch. 33) in relation to Saint John Baptist College in the University of Oxford duly passed at a General Meeting of the Governing Body of the said College specially summoned for this purpose on the fifteenth day of *December* one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six under Section 7 (2) of the said Act by the votes of not less than two-thirds of the number of the persons present and voting (notice of which has in accordance with Section 7 (2) of the said Act been given to the University of Oxford and which is not a Statute which affects the University of Oxford within the meaning of the said Section) and submitted to His Majesty the King in Council.

Whereas it appears to us the President and Fellows of the said College that it is desirable that certain Statutes of the said College shall be altered amended and added to in manner hereinafter appearing.

Now We the President and Fellows of the said College in exercise of the powers vested in us under and by virtue of Section 7 of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act 1923 Do by this present instrument under our Seal alter amend and add to the Statutes of the said College in manner following that is, to say:—

In Statute II Clause 1 by deleting from the clause the words "(a) Honorary Fellows and (b) during their periods of probation"

In Statute III Clause 1 by inserting after the words "in the" the words "Fellows of the College being members of the"

In Statute III Clause 3 by substituting the words "As soon as may be after the 31st *January* in any year in which it shall become known that a vacancy will occur on the 31st *July* in the office of President by retirement in accordance with the provisions of Clause 5 of this Statute, or as soon as it shall have become known that a vacancy has occurred in the office of President for any other reason," for the words "As soon as it shall have become known that a vacancy has occurred in the office of President,"; by substituting the word "Electors" in two places for the words "Governing Body"; and by inserting after the words "if the vacancy occur" the words "otherwise than in accordance with Clause 5 of this Statute"

In Statute III Clause 4 by deleting the word "Each" at the beginning of the clause and substituting therefor the words "At the meeting for election, each"; and by inserting the word "Official" in two places between the words "Senior" and "Fellow"
