crosses the road about 2,000 feet south-east of Rudgwick Railway Station.

## Eastern Boundary.

Thence along the railway in a north-westerly direction past Rudgwick Station and Baynards Station, in the County of Surrey, to the point where the railway crosses the road, about 400 feet south-east of Cranleigh Station. Thence following the road in a northerly direction to its junction with High Street, thence in an easterly and north-easterly direction along the Ewhurst Road to the road junction about 1 mile north-east of Cranleigh Station, thence along the road running in a northerly direction past Wyphurst House and Winterfold to the cross-roads about 700 feet west of Ewhurst Old Windmill.

## Northern Boundary.

Thence in a westerly direction along the forest road to Winterfold Heath, thence in a south-westerly direction along the road past Smithwood House and in a westerly direction to the junction of roads at Rushett Common, thence along the road in a southerly direction to Palmer's Cross, thence in a westerly direction along the road past Selhurst Common and Scotsland Farm and in a north-westerly direction to Thorncombe Street, thence in a southerly direction joining the main road from Godalming to Hascombe at Winkworth Farm. Thence along the main road in a north-westerly direction to the cross-roads at Munstead Wood, thence in a westerly direction to Busbridge Farm, thence in a north-westerly and westerly direction along Busbridge Lane to the junction of Shackstead Road and Ockford Road in the town of Godalming thence under the Southern Railway by Ockford Wood, thence in a southwesterly direction along the main road to the cross-roads at Milford, thence in a westerly direction to Manor Lodge and in a south-westerly direction along the road past Mousehill and Hammer Pond to Dye House, thence in a southerly direction to Pitch Place and in a westerly direction along the road passing Churt Common and in a northerly direction past Churt House passing along the eastern edge of Frensham Great Pond to Lane End. Thence along the road past the village of Frensham, Dockenfield Farm, and Batt's Corner, in the County of Southampton, crossing the main Farnham road at Bucks Horn Oak to the Inn at Blacknest the point of departure.
