The following Statute made by the Governing Body of Christ Church, in the University of Oxford, on the 27th day of January, 1937, has been submitted for the approval of His Majesty in Council, and notice of its having been so submitted is published in accordance with the provisions of "The Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923."

CHRIST CHURCH, OXFORD.

AMENDMENTS to the existing Statutes of Christ Church in the University of Oxford, duly made, under the provisions of the Universities of Oxford and Cambridge Act, 1923, at a Meeting of the Governing Body specially summoned for the purpose on the 27th January, 1937, and passed at that Meeting by the votes of two-thirds of the number of persons present and voting, and submitted to His Majesty The King in Council.

XXII.—THE SCHOLARSHIPS.

Clause 1:—

In paragraph 1, line 3, for "forty" read "forty-one."

In paragraph 1, line 5, after the words "in Classics" insert "the St. Cyres Scholarship in Modern History."

Add a new clause:—

9. An Open Scholarship in Modern History, known as the St. Cyres Scholarship, shall be offered from time to time at the discretion of the Governing Body as the funds of the Trust permit, out of the income of a

benefaction by the late Viscount St. Cyres, formerly Student of the House.

The Scholar shall be elected without limit of age and shall not be subject to an enquiry into his means. The emoluments shall be not less than £120 a year. In all other respects the Scholar elected shall be subject to the conditions laid down in Clauses 1-7 of this Statute.
