

Truro, and the said Norman Charles Hony (testified by their respectively signing this Scheme), do humbly recommend and propose to Your Majesty as follows, that is to say:—

“ 1. That the said Benefice of Michaelstow and the said Benefice of Saint Teath shall be permanently united together and form one Benefice with Cure of Souls under the style of ‘The United Benefice of Saint Teath with Michaelstow’ but the Parishes of the said Benefices shall continue distinct in all respects.

“ 2. That upon the day when any Order of Your Majesty in Council ratifying this Scheme shall be published in the London Gazette the union shall forthwith take effect and the said Norman Charles Hony if he is then Incumbent of the said Benefice of Saint Teath shall be the first Incumbent of the United Benefice.

“ 3. That upon the said union taking effect the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Saint Teath shall become and be the house of residence for the Incumbent of the United Benefice and so soon as conveniently may be the Parsonage House at present belonging to the said Benefice of Michaelstow and the site and appurtenances thereof and the grounds heretofore usually occupied and enjoyed therewith shall be sold and disposed of by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners at such time or times and in such manner in all respects as to us shall seem expedient and that the net proceeds of such sale shall be held and invested by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners for the benefit of the United Benefice.

“ 4. That upon the union taking effect a Curate shall be appointed at a stipend of not less than £250 per annum to assist the Incumbent in the performance of the duties of the United Benefice and such Curate shall reside at Delabole in the Parish of Saint Teath and shall be employed particularly to serve the Church of Saint John, at Delabole.

“ 5. That with the consent of the said Joseph Wellington, Bishop of Truro, as Patron of the said Benefice of Saint Teath (which consent is testified as aforesaid), upon the union taking effect a part of the total endowments of the Benefices hereinbefore recommended and proposed to be constituted an United Benefice, namely (a) an annual payment of £18 at present made by us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners to the Incumbent for the time being of the said Benefice of Saint Teath conditionally upon the performance of services to the satisfaction of the said Bishop of Truro in the said Church of Saint John, Delabole; (b) annual payments including a terminable grant of £90 per annum and amounting in all to £125 at present made by us to the Incumbent of the said Benefice of Saint Teath for his own use; (c) a sum of £1,455 19s. 3d. Local Loans £3 per cent. per annum Stock at present held by us the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners in trust for the said Benefice of Saint Teath; and (d) a proportion that is to say three one-eighth parts of the sum of money appropriated or to be appropriated by Queen Anne’s Bounty to the said Benefice of Saint Teath pursuant to the provisions of Part II 2 of the Third Schedule to the Tithe Act, 1936, and 1 of the Eighth Schedule to the same Act shall be severed or diverted from the said

Benefice of Saint Teath and from the United Benefice and shall be appropriated by us and by Queen Anne’s Bounty respectively for and towards the endowment of a proposed new District to comprise wholly or partly the locality of Delabole in the Parish of Saint Teath Provided always that pending the constitution of such new District it shall be lawful for us and for Queen Anne’s Bounty respectively to pay the income arising from the endowments so severed or diverted to the Incumbent for the time being of the United Benefice conditionally upon the employment of the Curate referred to in Clause 4 of this Scheme and in the event of such Curate not being so employed as aforesaid the said income shall be accumulated for and towards the endowment of the proposed new District.

“ 6. That after the said union has taken effect the course and succession in which the respective Patrons shall present or nominate to the United Benefice from time to time as the same shall become vacant shall be as follows, that is to say, the right of presentation shall be exercised by the Patrons of the said two Benefices alternately, the Patron of the said Benefice of Saint Teath having the right upon the first presentation to the United Benefice to be made after the union and every alternate right of presentation and the Patron of the said Benefice of Michaelstow having the right of presentation upon the second presentation to the United Benefice to be made after the union and every alternate turn thereafter.

“ Provided always that nothing herein contained shall prevent us from making any other recommendations and proposals relating to the matters aforesaid, or any of them, in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures, or of any other Measure of the National Assembly of the Church of England, or of any Act of Parliament ”.

And whereas drafts of the said Scheme have been duly published in accordance with the provisions of the said Measures, and Notices have been transmitted to the persons or bodies entitled under the same Measures to receive Notice requiring any objections to such draft Scheme to be stated or transmitted in writing to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules applicable to proceedings under the said Measures:

And whereas the prescribed time has elapsed and no such objections have been so stated or transmitted to the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners:

And whereas public notice of the certification to His Majesty in Council of the said Scheme and the consent thereto in writing of the Bishop of Truro has been duly given in the manner and within the time prescribed in the Statutory Rules aforesaid:

And whereas the said Scheme has been approved by His Majesty in Council:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His said Council, is pleased hereby to affirm the said Scheme and to order that the Benefices therein recommended to be united shall be united to the extent and for the purposes recommended in the said Scheme and further to order and direct that the said Scheme and every part thereof shall be
