

Rushall and over Wood Bridge to the road junction by the smithy at Manningford Bruce. Thence in a general north-north-easterly direction along the road which crosses the River Avon east of Lock Wood and passes east of Wilcot to Bristow Bridge and through Oare to the road junction about 1,000 feet east of Park Farm, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 127 square miles situated in the County of Dorset.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at the road junction by the Inn at Hartfoot Lane, situated in the County of Dorset about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles north of Cheselbourne and about 9 miles north-east of Dorchester, thence along the road running in a north-westerly and westerly direction past Cothayes Dairy to the road junction north of Nordon Hill. Thence for a short distance in a southerly and thence in a general westerly direction along the road through Dorsetshire Gap, past Folly, Ball Hill and Church Hill to the road junction about 1,700 feet south-east of Henley. Thence along the road in a southerly direction for about 300 feet to the road junction, thence in a westerly direction for about $1\frac{1}{2}$ miles to the road junction, thence for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile along the road running in a northerly and north-westerly direction to the cross-roads by the Tumulus, thence in a general south-westerly direction through Minterne Parva to the road junction by the Church at Up Cerne. Thence for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile along the road in a north-westerly direction to the road junction, thence in a general westerly direction past Wether Hill and Row Hill and passing south of Haydon Wood, through Holywell to the road junction about 800 feet east of the Church at Evershot.

Western Boundary.

Thence in a south-westerly direction along the road through Rampisham to Kingcombe Cross Roads, thence along the main road in a south-easterly direction to the road junction about 3,000 feet north-north-east of the Church at Toller Porcorum. Thence in a general south-westerly direction along the road through Toller Porcorum and passing east of Barrowland Farm, west of Woolcombe Farm and south of Eggardon Farms, to the cross-roads at Spyway, thence along the road in a southerly direction through Askerswell, and in a westerly direction to its junction with the main Dorchester-Bridport road about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile east of Vinney Cross. Thence along the road running in a southerly direction past Chilcombe and passing west of Puncknowle to the cross-roads about 200 feet south-west of the Church at Swyre.

Southern Boundary.

Thence in a south-easterly direction along the road past Tulk's Hill to Abbotsbury passing through the town by way of the road past the Church and the Mill to the point where the road crosses a stream about 1,000 feet south-east of the Mill. Thence following the right bank of the stream in a north-easterly direction to the point where it joins the road from Abbotsbury to Portisham about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile north-east of Linton Hill. Thence along the said road in an easterly and northerly

direction past Goose Hill to the point where it is crossed by the Great Western Railway near Portisham. Thence in an easterly direction along the railway past Shilvinghampton Halt to the point where it crosses Watery Lane west of Upwey Station. Thence eastwards along Watery Lane to its junction with the main Weymouth-Dorchester road.

Eastern Boundary.

Thence along the said main road in a northerly direction past Winterborne Monkton to its junction with the main road from Winterborne Abbas to Puddletown about 300 feet south-west of the Mills at Dorchester. Thence in an east-north-easterly direction along the latter main road for about $\frac{3}{4}$ mile to the fork-roads. Thence in a north-north-easterly direction passing east of Pigeon House Barn and past Laycock Barn to the road-junction at Higher Waterston. Thence along the road running in a general easterly direction past Lower Waterston and Druce Farm and in a northerly direction over Puddleton Down, past Chebbard Farm through Cheselbourne and past Giants Grave to the road junction by the Inn at Hartfoot Lane, the point of departure.

An Area of approximately 142 square miles situated in the Counties of Wilts and Somerset.

Northern Boundary.

Commencing at the point where the Great Western Railway crosses the main road from Warminster to Beckington near Standerwick in the County of Somerset, thence in an east-north-easterly direction along the railway to Westbury Railway Station in the County of Wilts. Thence along the road running in a north-easterly direction for about 1,300 feet to the road junction, thence along the road in a south-easterly direction to Westbury, passing through the town by way of West End, Alfred Street and Bratton Road. Thence along the main road running in an east-north-easterly direction past the Cemetery and Birchanger and through Bratton to the cross-roads about 800 feet north of Stradbrook. Thence in a south-easterly direction along the road past Stradbrook to the road junction about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile east-north-east of Thorncombe Farm. Thence in a northerly direction along the footpath to the junction of footpaths about 800 feet north of Patcombe Hill. Thence along the footpath running in a north-easterly direction for a distance of about 2,400 feet to the junction of footpaths, thence for about $\frac{1}{2}$ mile along the footpath in a southerly direction past West Down Farm to the junction of footpaths. Thence along the footpath running in a north-easterly direction for about 1,600 feet to the junction of footpaths. Thence along the footpath in an easterly direction for about 2,400 feet to its junction with a road. Thence along the road in a north-north-easterly direction to the road junction at Coulston Hill. Thence in a south-easterly direction along the road past Stoke Hill and Littleton Down to the cross-roads by the Tumulus on West Lavington Down. Thence in a north-easterly direction along the road past St. Joan à Gore's Cross to the cross-roads about 1,000 feet north-west of Brazen Bottom Farm. Thence in a south-
