easterly direction along the road past Brazen Bottom Farm to the cross-roads about 1,800 feet south-east of New Copse Farm.

## Eastern Boundary.

Thence along the road running in a southerly direction through Tilshead to the fork-roads north of White Barrow. Thence in a southerly direction along the road past Copehill Farm to the cross-roads about I mile west of Maddington Farm. Thence along the main road in an easterly direction for about  $\frac{1}{2}$  mile to the road junction, thence along the road in a southerly direction over Maddington Down and past Yarnbury Castle to its junction with the main road from Deptford to Winterbourne Stoke. Thence is an east-north-easterly direction along the said main road for about 1,700 feet to the road junction, thence in a southerly direction along the road over Steeple Langford Cow Down to the cross-roads at Steeple Langford.

## Southern Boundary.

Thence in a southerly and westerly direction along the road through Hanging Langford and Wylye, and past Bapton to the road junction at Stockton. ## Western Boundary.

Thence along the road running in a northnorth-easterly direction past Tyning Wood to Gare Hill and in a north-westerly direction past Marston Wood to the point where it crosses the Great Western Railway south of Haslett's Hill Farm in the County of Somerset. Thence along the railway in a north-north-easterly direction to Frome Railway Station and in a north-easterly direction to the point where it crosses the main road from Warminster to Beckington near Standerwick, the point of departure.
