2. In Clause 76 of the Scheme by adding the following new sub-clause (5) as under:—

"(5) This clause shall not apply to the share tonnages of such classes of coal during such allocation periods as may be determined by the Executive Board under the provisions of paragraph (vii) of sub-clause (2) of Clause 75."

MIDLAND (AMALGAMATED) DISTRICT (COAL
MINES) SCHEME, 1930.

Whereas in pursuance of Clause 39 of the Midland (Amalgamated) District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930, amendments of the said Scheme as set out in the Schedule hereto have been submitted to the Board of Trade by the Executive Board elected under the provisions of the said Scheme:

Now therefore the Board of Trade under the provisions of the said Clause and of subsection (5) of Section 1 of the Coal Mines Act, 1930, hereby approve the said amendments and prescribe the 29th day of April, 1937, as the date from which the said amendments shall come into force.

SCHEDULE.

The Midland (Amalgamated) District (Coal Mines) Scheme, 1930 (hereinafter referred to as "the Scheme") shall be amended in the following manner, that is to say:—

Clause 24 of the Scheme shall have effect as if:—

(i) For sub-clause (1) there were substituted the following new sub-clause, that is to say:—"If the operation of the Act be extended beyond the 31st day of December, 1937, then immediately after the 30th day of April, 1938, and after the 30th day of April in each subsequent year, the Executive Board shall ascertain the tonnage of external coal despatched by each Coalowner in the District for inland supply during the twelve months ended on any such date (which period is in this Clause referred to as a trade year), and also the total of the monthly permitted inland supplies of each such Coalowner for that trade year after deduction therefrom of any tonnage of coal supplied from the coal mine of such Coalowner for consumption in his excluded works.";

(ii) In sub-clause (2) the words "(after deduction in each case of any tonnages of coal supplied to excluded works)" were deleted and the following words substituted

therefor, namely:—" (after deduction in each case of any tonnage of coal supplied from the coal mine of any Coalowner to his excluded works) ";

(iii) In sub-clause (6) the words "(after deduction in each case of any tonnages of coal supplied to excluded works)" were deleted and the following words substituted therefor, namely:—" (after deduction in each case of any tonnage of coal supplied from the coal mine of any Coalowner to his excluded works) ";

(iv) Sub-clause (8) were deleted.
