DANGEROUS DRUGS ACTS, 1920-1932.

The Secretary of State for the Home Department gives notice that he has made new Regulations under the Dangerous Drugs Acts as follows:

Under Section 3 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, Regulations for controlling and restricting the possession, sale and distribution of the drugs to which Part I of that Act as amended by the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1925, applies. The principal object of the Regulations is to consolidate the provisions of seven separate sets of Regulations at present in force.

Under Section 7 of the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1920, Regulations for controlling the manufacture, sale, possession and distribution of the drugs to which Part III of that Act as amended by the Dangerous Drugs Act, 1932, applies. The principal object of the Regulations is to consolidate with amendments four separate sets of the Regulations at present in force.

The Regulations, which are dated 18th June, come into force on 1st July, 1937.

METALLIFEROUS MINES AND QUARRIES.

The Secretary for Mines gives notice that on the 14th day of June, 1937, he made General Regulations under Sections 85 and 86 of the Coal Mines Act, 1911, amending the Coal Mines General Regulations (First Aid), 1930, to require that first-aid rooms and first-aid and other boxes provided at mines under the Act shall be marked with the words "First Aid instead of a white cross on a red ground.

The Regulations, which may be cited as the Coal Mines (First-aid) Amending Regulations, 1937, come into force on the 30th day of June,

1937.
The Secretary for Mines also gives notice that on the 14th day of June, 1937, he made an Order under Section 29 of the Workmen's Compensation Act, 1923, amending the Order of 1st March, 1924 (S.R. & O. 1924 No. 282), to require a similar alteration in the marking of firstaid boxes and cupboards provided at quarries and pit-banks of metalliferous mines.
