hereas by Our Proclamation bearing Date the Twenty fecond day of August last, publica notice was given. That in pursuance of his Pases sty's Royal Pleasure lignified to Us for Incorporating the Commission Officers of the several Resiments lately Disbanded in this Kingdom, into the Regiments that are to stand and remain on the Establishment of Ireland, The had given the necessary Directions to the Commanding Officers of each of the standing Regiments, to receive and Post their respective proportions of the said Disbanded Officers according to the Distribution in Our said

Proclamation let down, to the end they might for the future do Duty and receive Pay with the several Regiments into which they Mould be respectively Incorporated; And that such Officers might have sufficient time to order their own private Affairs, We made known that the absence of such of them as the distance they were at from the Regiments oid make it necessary, should be dispensed with till the 15th day of November next. And whereas, we have taken into Dur Consideration the Inconvenience it may be to the Country to Quarter more Officers than are at present with the several Regiments of His Waschy's Forces in this Kingdom, till other Plovision can be made for their Accommodation by Building of Barraques at certain places, pursuant to the
