##### FOOT-AND-MOUTH DISEASE (INFECTED AREAS) ORDER OF 1937 (No. 21).

##### SUBJECT.

Declares the area described in the Schedule to be a Foot-and-Mouth Disease Infected Area for the purposes of the Foot-and-Mouth Disease (Infected Areas Restrictions) Order of 1925.

##### SCHEDULE.

An Area comprising:—

*In the County of the North Riding of Yorkshire.*

The borough of Richmond.

The petty sessional divisions of Gilling West, Hang East, Gilling East, Hang West (*except the parishes of Bishopdale, Hawes, High Abbotside and that part of the parish of Bainbridge as lies to the south-west of the road from Buckden via Kedstones Fell, Bank Wood, Stalling Busk and Countersett to Buttersett*) and Greta Bridge (*except the parishes of Lunedale, Holwick, Mickleton and Romaldkirk*).

The parishes of Thrintoft, Yafforth, Ainderby Steeple, Morton-upon-Swale, Great Smeaton, Little Smeaton, Birkby, Hutton Bonville, and Lazenby.
