TENDERS FOR TREASURY BILLS.

I. The Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that Tenders will be received at the Bill Office, at the Bank of England, on Friday, the 24th September, 1937, at I o'clock, for Treasury Bills to be issued under the Treasury Bills Act, 1877, the National Debt Act, 1889, and the War Loan Acts, 1914-1919, to the amount of \pounds 50,000,000.

2. The Bills will be in amounts of $f_{5,000}$ or $f_{10,000}$. They will be dated at the option of the Tenderer on any business day from Monday, the 27th September, 1937, to Saturday, the 2nd October, 1937, inclusive, and will be payable at three months after date.

3. The Bills will be issued and paid at the Bank of England. 4. Each Tender must be for an amount not

4. Each Tender must be for an amount not less than $f_{50,000}$, and must specify the date on which the Bills required are to be dated, and the net amount per cent. (being an even multiple of one penny) which will be given
