The KING has been pleased to give directions for the appointment of Carmichael Wilson, Esq., M.B., B.Ch. (Senior Medical Officer), to be a Member of the Executive Council and an Official Member of the Legislative Council of the Gambia.

The Secretary for Mines has appointed Mr. Harold Frederick Wilson to be a Junior Inspector of Mines under the Coal Mines Acts, 1887 to 1919, and has instructed him to act also as an Inspector for the purposes of the Metalliferous Mines Regulation Acts, 1872 and 1875, and of the Quarries Act, 1894.

Under the provisions of the Mining Industry Act, 1920 and of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, the Secretary for Mines has further appointed Mr. Wilson to be an Inspector of Factories and Workshops for the purposes of the Factory and Workshop Act, 1901, so far as it applies to quarries and pitbanks as defined in Part II of the Sixth Schedule to that Act.
