ORDER OF THE REGISTRAR-GENERAL. IN ENGLAND.

(Dated 3rd September, 1937.) No. 10/1937.

Whereas the Superintendent Registrar's district of Carlisle is situate partly within and partly without the County Borough of Carlisle;

And whereas the part without the County Borough will, on the 1st day of October, 1937, in consequence of and by virtue of the Carlisle Registration Scheme, 1937, made by the Council of the County Borough of Carlisle and approved by the Minister of Health under Section 24 of the Local Government Act, 1929, become a separate Superintendent Registrar's district;

And whereas it is expedient that on the formation of the separate Superintendent Registrar's district as aforesaid provision should be made for its union with the Superintendent Registrar's district of Brampton and for the rearrangement of the sub-districts comprised therein;

And whereas it is necessary to transfer the functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the part of the Superintendent Registrar's district of Carlisle which is situate without the County Borough of Carlisle;

Now, therefore, the Registrar-General of Births, Deaths and Marriages in England, in exercise of the powers conferred by Sections 10 and 11 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1837, Section 21 of the Births and Deaths Registration Act, 1874, Section 21 (2) of the Local Government Act, 1929, and of all other powers in that behalf, with the approval and sanction of the Minister of Health, hereby orders as follows:—

- 1.—(1) This Order may be cited as the Carlisle and County of Cumberland Registration of Births, etc., Order, 1937, and shall come into operation on the 1st day of October, 1937.
- (2) In this Order the term "district" means a Superintendent Registrar's district, and the terms "existing district" and "existing subdistrict" mean respectively a district and a sub-district which existed immediately before the 1st day of October, 1937.
- 2. That portion of the existing Carlisle district which will on the 1st day of October, 1937, become a separate district situate wholly without the County Borough of Carlisle shall be united with the existing district of Brampton into one district which shall be called the Border district.
- 3. The existing Burgh, Dalston, Stanwix and Wetheral sub-districts shall be united into one sub-district which shall be called the Eden sub-district.
- 4. The Superintendent Registrar of the existing Brampton district shall be the Superintendent Registrar of the Border district as constituted by this Order.
- 5. The Registrar of Births and Deaths of the existing Stanwix sub-district shall be the Registrar of Births and Deaths of the Eden sub-district as constituted by this Order.
- 6. The functions under the Registration Acts in relation to the part of the existing Carlisle district which is situate without the County

Borough of Carlisle are hereby transferred to the Council of the Administrative County of Cumberland.
