LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

River Severn Catchment Board.

West Gloucestershire Internal Drainage Board.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the Order made on the 19th August, 1937, in relation to the Scheme prepared by the River Severn Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the extension of the period of office of the first members of the West Gloucestershire Internal Drainage Board until the 1st day of November, 1938.

A copy of the Order may be seen at all reasonable hours at the Office of the Clerk of the Catchment Board, 2, College Yard, Worcester, and also at the Offices of the Ministry of Agriculture and Fisheries, 10, Whitehall Place, London, S.W.1.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act, or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
