## SALMON AND FRESHWATER FISHERIES ACT, 1923.

### RIVER TOWY DISTRICT FISHERY ORDER, 1937.

### LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

#### *Merionethshire Rivers Catchment Area.*
