ROAD TRAFFIC ACT, 1930.

NOTICE is hereby given that in pursuance of the Bristol Transport Act, 1937, and Part V of the Road Traffic Act, 1930, application has been made by the Council of the City and County of Bristol (hereinafter called "The Corporation") to the Traffic Commissioners of the Western Traffic Area for their consent to the running by the Corporation of Public Service Vehicles on roads within that Traffic Area outside the City and County of Bristol, along the following roads, that is to say:—
