From the City Boundary on Road A.420 at South Road along Road A.420 (Regent Street and High Street) to its junction with Hill Street.

From the City Boundary on Road B.4427 (High Street) at Cassell Road along Road B.4427 (High Street and Broad Street) to its junction with Park Road.

From the City Boundary on Road A.431 (Hanham Street) at Dundry Lane along Road A.431 (Hanham Street) to its junction with Victoria Road.

In the Rural District of Sodbury—

From the City Boundary on Road B.4056 (Southmead Road) at Dunkeld Avenue along B.4056 (Southmead Road), Road A.38 (Gloucester Road, North), Station Road and unclassified Road to Stoke Gifford (Southern end of Hatchet Lane).

From the City Boundary on Filton Avenue between Eden Grove and Sixth Avenue along Filton Avenue to Walls Court Road.

From the City Boundary on Road A.38 (Gloucester Road, North) between Eden Grove and Northville Road along Road A.38 to its junction with Gypsy Patch Lane.

In the Rural District of Keynsham—

From the City Boundary on Road A.37 at White Cross Avenue along Road A.37 to Whitchurch Cross Roads at Whitchurch.

BOROUGH OF RAMSGATE.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT, 1932.

BOROUGH OF RAMSGATE PLANNING
SCHEME NO. 4.

NOTICE is hereby given that (1) on the 15th day of October, 1937, the Minister of Health notified his approval of the resolution of the Ramsgate Borough Council dated the 1st day of July, 1937, deciding to prepare the above planning scheme with reference to an area situate within the Borough of Ramsgate; (2) the Map defining the area to which the resolution applies has been deposited at the Borough Engineer and Surveyor's Office, 16, Albion Place, Ramsgate, and will be open for inspection by all persons interested without charge between the hours of 9.15 a.m. and 5.15 p.m. (Saturdays 9.15 a.m. and 12.30 p.m.); (3) any person who is, or claims to be, an owner of any property in the area and any association representing owners of property within the Borough of Ramsgate and any local association representing business or industry may by notice in writing, specifying in the case of an owner the property of which he claims to be the owner, require the Ramsgate Borough Council to register without charge his or their name and address for the service of subsequent notices relating to the scheme.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Ramsgate Borough Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

The Ramsgate Borough Council intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Town Clerk, Albion House, Ramsgate.
