

WE, the Ecclesiastical Commissioners for England, acting in pursuance of the Act of the 29th and 30th years of Her late Majesty Queen Victoria, chapter III, section 5. do hereby, subject as hereinafter mentioned, make out of our Common Fund to the Incumbent for the time being of each of the Benefices whereof the names and the names of the counties and dioceses wherein the same are respectively situate are stated in the first three columns of the Schedule hereto, and to his successors Incumbents of the same Benefice, a grant of a sum to be calculated at the yearly rate stated in the fourth column of the said Schedule opposite to the name of the Benefice, for the period commencing as from the date stated in the fifth column of the said Schedule and terminating on the 1st day of May, 1938 (unless at any time before the expiration of the said period the grant of such sum shall have been cancelled or withdrawn by a resolution of us, the said Ecclesiastical Commissioners), and to be payable so long as the same shall continue in quarterly instalments on the 1st day of February, the 1st day of May, the 1st day of August, and the 1st day of November: Provided always that the sum so granted or any

quarterly portion thereof shall be payable only upon the production to us on or after each of the said quarterly days of payment of a certificate (in such form as may be required by us) under the hand of the Bishop of the Diocese in which the Benefice is situate certifying that, during the quarter then ended, there has been employed within the Parish of the Benefice and duly licensed by such Bishop such Assistant Curate as is indicated in the sixth column of the said Schedule, and that such Assistant Curate has been in receipt of a stipend after a rate of not less than £150 per annum: Provided also that such sum is granted upon and is payable only subject to the satisfaction of the further conditions (if any) stated with reference thereto at the foot of the said Schedule: Provided lastly that this Instrument which is intended to be executed in several parts (one part for each Diocese concerned) shall operate only as a single grant in favour of each of the Benefices mentioned in the said Schedule.
