The KING has been graciously pleased to grant unto the Right Honourable William John Arthur Charles James Duke of Portland, K.G., G.C.V.O., T.D., the Office of Chancellor of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, vacant by the resignation of the Right Reverend Thomas Banks Strong, G.B.E., D.D., late Bishop of Oxford.

The KING has been pleased to grant unto Peter Lawrence Mortimer (formerly Peter Lawrence Jamison), Esquire, Lieutenant in the Royal Navy, His Royal Licence and Authority that he may assume and henceforth use the Arms of Mortimer and that such Arms may be assumed and used by his issue; the said Arms being first duly exemplified according to the Laws of Arms and recorded in His Majesty's College of Arms otherwise the said Royal Licence and permission to be void and of none effect.

And to command that the said Royal concession and declaration be recorded in His Majesty's said College of Arms.
