## RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

## IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the aforesaid London Traffic Act to make Regulations in regard to a system of “one-way” traffic working in Newman Street, Berners Mews, Wells Street, Eastcastle Street, Margaret Street, Great Titchfield Street and Market Place.

And notice is hereby further given that on account of urgency the Minister of Transport has under Section 2 of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, made the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (Oxford Street) Provisional Regulations, 1937, to bring into force the above-mentioned scheme on the 29th day of November, 1937, as Provisional Regulations to continue in force until Regulations have been made in accordance with the provisions of Section 1 of that Act.
