

the Company; contracts by directors; appointment of auditors and indemnities for the issue of duplicate certificates.

11. To authorise the Company to provide maintain and equip recreation grounds for the use of employees of the Company.

12. To make new provision as to the quorum at general meetings of the Company.

13. To confer further powers on the Company with regard to the recovery of charges for gas; the giving of notices by consumers to discontinue the supply of gas and as to satisfaction for damage caused to pipes pillars and lamps belonging to the Company.

14. To confer upon the Company any other powers commonly conferred upon gas companies.

15. The Order will vary or extinguish all rights or privileges which would impede or interfere with its provisions and will confer other rights or privileges.

16. To repeal alter or amend all or any of the provisions of the existing Acts and Orders of the Company and to incorporate with the Order with or without modification or to render inapplicable to the Company all or some of the provisions of the Lands Clauses Acts, the Companies Clauses Consolidation Act 1845, the Companies Clauses Act 1863, the Gasworks Clauses Act 1847 and the Gasworks Clauses Act 1871.

Any local or other public authority company or person desiring to bring before the Board of Trade any objection to the draft Order may do so by registered letter addressed to the Director of Gas Administration Board of Trade, Great George Street, London, S.W.1, and despatched on or before the 18th day of February 1938.

Any such objection shall state:—

(a) the specific grounds of objection; and

(b) the omissions additions or modifications asked for.

A copy of the objection must at the same time be forwarded to the Company or to the undermentioned Solicitors and Parliamentary Agents.

A copy of the draft Special Order has been deposited for public inspection at the chief office of the Company Katharine Street Croydon, at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County of Surrey at the County Hall Kingston-on-Thames and at the office of the Clerk of the Peace for the County Borough of Croydon at the Town Hall Croydon.
