RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS, 1930 TO 1937.

Notice is hereby given under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Minister of Transport after the expiry of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by the Road Traffic Acts, 1930 to 1937, to make the Heavy Goods Vehicles (Driver's Licences) Amendment Regulations, 1938, to provide that the requirement that the holder of a provisional licence to drive a heavy goods vehicle shall be accompanied by a properly qualified person who shall be present in the vehicle with him, shall

not apply in the case of a vehicle which is not constructed or adapted to carry more than one person.

River Lune Catchment Area.
