Funds.—The Supreme Court Funds Rules, 1927, provide that:—

(1) On or before the 1st day of March, 1928, and in every succeeding fifth year the Accountant-General shall prepare, in such form and with such particulars as the Treasury may from time to time direct, a list or statement of the accounts in the books of the Pay Office to the credit of which there stood on the 1st day of September then next preceding any funds not less than 50*l.*, which have not been dealt with, otherwise than by the continuous investment or placing on deposit of interest, during the 15 years immediately preceding the last-mentioned date.

The said list or statement shall be filed in the Central Office and a copy thereof shall be inserted in the "London Gazette" and exhibited in the several offices of the Court.

The Accountant-General may, in his discretion, give any information respecting any funds in Court mentioned in such list or statement upon a request signed by the person applying for such information or by his solicitor. If such request be made by a solicitor, such information shall not be given unless the request states the name and address of the person on whose behalf it is made, and that such person is in the opinion of the applicant beneficially interested in such funds. If such request be made by any person other than a solicitor, such information shall not be given unless the applicant is able to satisfy the Accountant-General that the request is such as may in the particular case be properly complied with.

The Accountant-General may omit from such list or statement any account in respect of which he may be informed by or on behalf of a person claiming to be interested therein that an Order dealing therewith will be applied for, any account the funds standing to the credit of which have been lodged under Rule 40 of these Rules and remained undealt with for a period not exceeding 20 years, and any account which has been included in such list or statement for a period of 15 years. (Rule 96.)

In pursuance of the above Rule, the following Alphabetical List of Accounts in the several Divisions of the High Court, which have not been dealt with *since 1st September, 1922*, is published in the "London Gazette" for general information, together with an Index of Names, and cross-references to the sub-titles of the several accounts.

This List and those published in 1923, 1928 and 1933 are the only authorized Lists of dormant or unclaimed Funds in Court.*

Amount.—The aggregate amount of the funds published in this List is about £370,000, distributed over more than 1,200 separate accounts. Considerably more than one-half do not exceed £150 in value, and only about one-twentieth exceed £1,000.

Applications.—Each application for information concerning funds in Court should be addressed to THE CHIEF ACCOUNTANT, SUPREME COURT PAY OFFICE, ROYAL COURTS OF JUSTICE, LONDON, W.C.2, and *must quote the correct title of the matter or suit, be signed by the applicant and stamped with a 2s. 6d. impressed Judicature Fee Stamp (see below)*.

If the application be made by a person who is not a Solicitor, he must state the grounds upon which he claims to be beneficially interested in the fund. The mere fact that he bears the same surname as that of a person named in an account is not sufficient. Probates of Wills, or baptismal or other certificates, should *not* accompany an application.

If the application be made by a Solicitor, he must state the name and address of the client by whom he is instructed, and that he believes him to be beneficially interested in the fund.

Information.—A person desiring information as to the origin of a fund in Court may in most cases obtain it by inspecting the Orders, &c., of the Court quoted in the List (see Note below). If he finds reason to believe that he may be interested in a particular fund he may apply, *in writing only*, to The Chief Accountant, Supreme Court Pay Office (see instructions above), who may supply information as to—

(a) The amount of the Fund.

(b) The date of any Order of Court known to relate to it, other than that stated in the

List.

This is usually the only information which can be furnished, as the Supreme Court Pay Office is solely an Office of Accounts, and has no record of the origin or details of the various suits, or of the circumstances under which the funds have been directed or allowed to remain in Court, neither has it any information enabling it to reply to enquiries as to descent or relationship.

The Chief Accountant is only able to answer enquiries relating to funds that have been lodged in Court in England. He is not in a position to supply information regarding the administration of estates or concerning estates which are supposed to be derelict. He is unable to answer enquiries respecting Scottish or Irish estates. Estates are not administered by the Court in Scotland, but enquiries concerning estates which have fallen to the Crown as *ultimus haeres* in default of heirs should be addressed to the King's and Lord Treasurer's Remembrancer, Exchequer Chambers, Edinburgh. Enquiries regarding the succession to other Scottish estates should be addressed to the Keeper of the Registers and Records, H.M. General Register House, Edinburgh. The Accountant of the Courts of Justice, Dublin, has charge of the funds under the control of the Supreme Court and High Court of Justice in Eire. Enquiries in connexion with funds lodged in Court in Northern Ireland may be addressed to the Accountant-General Law Courts, Belfast, but it should be remembered that the Supreme Court in Northern Ireland was not instituted until the year 1921.

* Copies of this List can be inspected, without fee, in the Eastern Corridor, ground floor, at the Royal Courts of Justice, or may be purchased from H.M. Stationery Office, Imperial House, Kingsway, London, W.C.2, at the price of 2s. Applications to the publishers for copies to be sent by post must enclose a sufficient amount to cover postage, in addition to the cost of the Gazette. The Gazette is registered at the General Post Office for transmission by Inland Post as a newspaper. The postage rate to places within the United Kingdom is 1½d. For places abroad the rate is 2d., except in the case of Canada, to which the rate, by Canadian Magazine Post, is 1½d.

Stamps.—Each application must be stamped with a 2s. 6d. impressed Judicature Fee Stamp and can be so stamped at the Royal Courts of Justice (Rooms 6 and 140) and at the District Registries of the High Court in Liverpool or Manchester.

Payment for stamps on applications from the country may be made by Money or Postal Order which should be made payable to "The Commissioners of Inland Revenue," but applications from abroad should enclose an International Money Order.

Coin, or postage stamps, must not be sent.

Orders of Court.—Funds in Court can only be paid out, or otherwise dealt with, under the direction of an Order of Court. As a rule, a fund cannot be dealt with under any existing Order, and consequently application to the Court for further directions is usually necessary. Such application must be made through the usual legal channels. In many cases the funds have remained in Court for upwards of a century, and proof of title might involve expense quite out of proportion to the amount recoverable. Owing to the difficulty of establishing such proof, payment out of funds which have remained undealt with for upwards of fifty years is very rare. No legal advice can be given at the Supreme Court Pay Office as to the steps necessary to be taken in any particular case; nor can advice be given as to the selection of a Solicitor.

Caution.—The lists of "next-of-kin," "heirs to unclaimed money," &c., issued by various persons, are not official publications, and sometimes contain gross mis-statements and exaggerations.

The public are also cautioned against relying upon the statements of persons styling themselves "unclaimed money agents," at home or abroad, and professing to be able to recover money in Chancery on payment of fees or percentage, or to act on behalf of the "Court of Chancery." The Supreme Court of Judicature has no such agents.

It is recommended that independent advice should be obtained before making a payment to any agency for information, searches, copies of advertisements, &c., with respect to money alleged to be in Court. Experience has shown that the information so supplied is often valueless to the persons concerned.

NOTE.—Orders, Reports and Certificates prior to 1921, and Affidavits prior to 1921, referred to in the List are kept at the Legal Room, Public Record Office, Chancery Lane, London, W.C.2, where they can be inspected on personal application, and on payment of the prescribed search fees. Copies may be obtained on application to the Secretary, if the date of the document and the title of the cause be given, but it must be understood that no search can be undertaken by the officials of the Public Record Office. Orders and Certificates from 1921 and Affidavits from 1921 to the present time are kept at the Filing and Record Department of the Central Office, Royal Courts of Justice (Room 81).

Enquiries respecting Wills, Probates and Letters of Administration may be made personally at the Principal Probate Registry, Somerset House, London, W.C.2, or by letter addressed to "The Record Keeper," at that address.

Records of Births, Marriages and Deaths, since 1st July, 1837, are kept at the General Register Office, Somerset House, London, W.C.2.

All the above-mentioned documents can be inspected during official hours, or copies can be obtained on payment of the prescribed Fees.

Application to inspect Orders in Lunacy should be made to the Master in Lunacy, Room 210, Royal Courts of Justice, London, W.C.2.
