At the Court at *Buckingham Palace*, the 15th day of *March*, 1938.

PRESENT,

The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS by the Osborne Estate Act, 1914, it is enacted that His Majesty may, by Order in Council, add to the persons for whose benefit the part of Osborne House mentioned in paragraph (b) of sub-section (4) of section one of the Osborne Estate Act, 1902, is to be used, such other classes of persons as, subject to such conditions and restrictions as may be imposed by the Order, He may determine to be qualified on account of their public services to participate in such benefit, and may from time to time by Order in Council revoke or vary any such Order:

And whereas His Majesty, in pursuance of the said Act, was pleased on the twenty-eighth day of November, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-three, by Order in Council (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Order") to order that certain classes of persons specified in the principal Order should, subject to the conditions and restrictions therein specified, be eligible to participate in such benefit:

And whereas it is expedient to extend further the classes of persons eligible to participate in such benefit:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

In addition to the persons heretofore eligible to participate in such benefit the following persons shall be eligible, subject to the con-

ditions and restrictions in the principal Order specified, that is to say:—

(a) All male persons serving in an established capacity in the Civil Service of Great Britain.

(b) All male persons serving in an established capacity in the Civil Service of Northern Ireland.
