LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

River Nene Catchment Board.

Wingland Internal Drainage District.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries has made an Order under the Land Drainage Act, 1930, confirming the Order made on the 24th February, 1938, in relation to the Scheme prepared by the River Nene Catchment Board, under Section 4 (1) (b) of the Act, making provision for the constitution of the Wingland Internal Drainage District and of a Drainage Board therefor, the abolition of the Nene Outfall Commissioners, the abrogation of the powers of the Commissioners of Sewers for the County of Norfolk, and for matters supplemental thereto.

By Part III of the Second Schedule to the said Act, it is provided that if any person aggrieved by an Order desires to question its validity on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Act or that any requirement of the Act has not been complied with, he may, within six weeks after the publication of this notice, make an application for the purpose to the High Court, and if any such application is duly made, the Court, if satisfied that the

Order is not within the powers of the Act, or that the interests of the applicant have been substantially prejudiced by any requirements of the Act not having been complied with, may quash the Order either generally or in so far as it affects the applicant.
