### RULES PUBLICATION ACT, 1893.

#### IN THE MATTER OF THE LONDON TRAFFIC ACT, 1924.

The Minister of Transport hereby gives notice under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that he proposes after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date in pursuance of the powers conferred upon him by Section 10 of the London Traffic Act, 1924, to make the London Traffic (Prescribed Routes) (No. ) (Cheyne Walk, Chelsea) Regulations, 1938, in regard to a scheme of "one-way" traffic working in that part of Cheyne Walk, Chelsea, which lies between Oakley Street and Flood Street, from West to East.
