NOTICE is hereby given that on the 25th April, 1938, the Minister of Transport confirmed the County Council of Lancashire (Clitheroe Rural District Traffic Regulation and Restriction) Order, 1937, made by the Lancashire County Council under Section 29 of the Road Traffic Act, 1930 and Section 29 of the Road and Rail Traffic Act, 1933. The Order as confirmed provides that no person shall (a) drive or cause to be driven any vehicle on either length of road specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto otherwise than in the direction specified opposite to such length of road in the second coloumn of the said Schedule and (b) subject to certain exceptions, drive or cause to be driven on either of the said roads any heavy locomotive, light locomotive, motor tractor, heavy motor car or motor car with seats for more than 8 persons.
