LEOMINSTER GAS (CAPITAL POWERS) ORDER, 1938.

(Application for an Order under Section 1 of the Gas Undertakings Act, 1929.)

BIRKENHEAD GAS.

(Application for Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934).

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the County Borough of Birkenhead (hereinafter referred to as "the Corporation") whose address is the Town Hall, Birkenhead, intend to apply to the Board of Trade for a Special Order under the Gas Undertakings Acts 1920 to 1934, for all or some of the following purposes (that is to say):—

To extend the limits within which the Corporation are authorised to supply gas so as to include in addition to their existing limits of supply so much of the county borough of Birkenhead as prior to the coming into operation of the County of Chester Review Order 1933 formed part of the parish of Bidstone-cum-Ford in the rural district of Wirral and is not within their existing limits of supply (hereinafter referred to as "the added limits").

To authorise the Corporation within the added limits to exercise all and the like powers rights privileges and authorities for and in relation to the supply and distribution of gas and the opening and breaking up of streets and roads as they now have within their existing limits of supply.

To make provision as to the price to be charged by the Corporation for gas supplied in the added limits.

To authorise the Corporation to erect maintain alter improve and renew gasworks with all necessary machinery and apparatus and to make and store gas and to work up and convert residual products upon the lands hereinafter described and to purchase and use material required to work up and convert residual products. The said lands are:—

A piece of land situate in the county borough of Birkenhead containing 3,080 square yards or thereabouts bounded on the north by Blackpool Street on the east in part by Cambridge Place and in other part by Elizabeth Place on the west by the land described in the Schedule to the Birkenhead Gas Order 1930 (S.R. & O. 1930 No. 165) and on the south by the lands described in the Schedule to the Birkenhead Corporation Act 1881 (44 & 45 Vict. ch. 153).
