SEA-FISHING INDUSTRY ACTS,
1933 AND 1938.

The following Order under Section 2 of the Sea-Fishing Industry Act, 1933, and Section 39 of the Sea Fish Industry Act, 1938, was made on the 27th July, 1938, by the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, the Secretary of State for Scotland and the Secretary of State for the Home Department:—

The Sea-Fishing Industry (Restriction of Fishing in Northern Waters) Order, 1938.

This Order provides that no person shall during the months of June and July in any year, land in the United Kingdom any sea-fish other than lobsters, crabs, shrimps, prawns, oysters, mussels, cockles and any other kind of shell-fish, which have been caught in waters situate

(a) to the northward of a line drawn along the parallel of latitude 71° 10' 10" north from the east coast of Greenland to the North Cape of Norway and to the westward of the meridian of the North Cape of Norway (longitude 25° 47' 20" east); or

(b) to the northward of the parallel of latitude 64° north and to the eastward of the meridian of the North Cape of Norway (longitude 25° 47' 20" east).

This Order came into force on the 28th July, 1938.

LAND DRAINAGE ACT, 1930.

Merionethshire Rivers Catchment Board.

Notice is hereby given that the Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, in exercise of the powers conferred upon him under Section 4 (3) of the Land Drainage Act, 1930, proposes to make an Order confirming a scheme submitted to him by the Merionethshire Rivers Catchment Board under Section 4 (1) (a) of the Act, for the transfer to the Catchment Board of all

such rights, powers, duties, obligations and liabilities (including liabilities incurred in connection with works) over or in connection with the main river as were immediately before the commencement of the said Act vested in or to be discharged by the Harlech Marsh Drainage Authority, the Ardudwy Marsh Drainage Authority, or by any other drainage authority, and of any property held by the said authorities or by any other drainage authority, for the purpose of, or in connection with, any functions so to be transferred.

A copy of the draft Order, together with a copy of the scheme, as amended, has been deposited at the Office of the Clerk of the Catchment Board, Tremeivion, Talsarnau, Merionethshire, for public inspection for a period of thirty-one days from the date of this notice and may be inspected during the ordinary hours of business.
