### CITY OF PLYMOUTH PLANNING SCHEME No. 2.

Under the Town and Country Planning (General Interim Development) Order, 1933,\* the development of land in the area during the preparation of the scheme is permitted to the extent specified in the Order and in addition the Plymouth City Council are empowered to permit other development in the area during this period, with a view in either case to protecting the development from the risk of removal or alteration without compensation under the scheme when approved and in operation. A print of the Order has been deposited together with the aforesaid Map.

The Plymouth City Council intend to proceed as soon as may be with the preparation of a Draft Scheme and any suggestions as to the proposals to be included in the Draft Scheme should be sent in writing to the Clerk to the Council.
