BOROUGH OF LUTON.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Mayor Aldermen and Burgesses of the Borough of Luton have applied to the Minister of Health for a Provisional Order under Section 140 of the Local Government Act, 1933, to alter the boundaries of the Borough so as to include within the Borough a portion of the Parish of Hyde containing approximately 502 acres now forming part of the Luton Rural District in the County of Bedford, and that a duplicate of the Map "B" deposited with the Minister and showing (amongst other things) the existing boundaries of the Borough and the proposed alterations thereof, has been deposited at my office and will be open to inspection at all reasonable hours, without payment, by any Local Authority or person affected by the proposals

Notice of objections to the proposals should be sent to the Minister of Health, Whitehall, S.W.1, and to the Town Council within two weeks from the date of the publication of this notice and a full statement of the objections should be forwarded to the Minister and to the Town Council within a further period of four weeks
